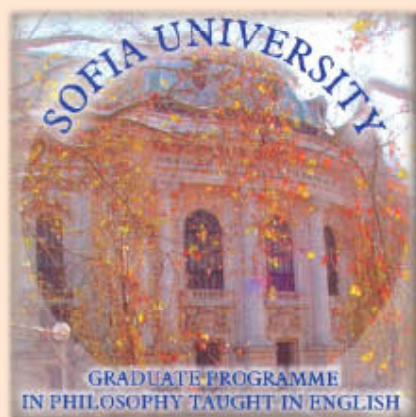


MASTER'S AND DOCTORAL STUDIES IN PHILOSOPHY TAUGHT IN ENGLISH AT SOFIA UNIVERSITY



The Program meets the principal requirements of the European Union graduate studies. These degrees are recognized worldwide. ECTS credits are awarded. Faculty is with broad international experience in teaching and research. Bulgaria is a member of the European Union since January 1, 2007.



Courses offered: Continental Philosophy, Social Philosophy, Axiology, Applied Ethics, Philosophy of Language, Psychoanalysis and Philosophy, Philosophy of Science, Philosophical Anthropology, Philosophical Method, Epistemology, Philosophy for Children, Philosophy of Intercultural Relations, Truth and Method, Philosophy of Subjective Action. Logic in the Continental Tradition, Philosophy of Culture, Renaissance Philosophy.

Opportunity to write a master's thesis or doctoral dissertation on a topic of your own choice including Asian Philosophy.

Eligibility Requirement: bachelor's or master's degree.

Financial aid: scholarships for BG/EU/EEA citizens including full tuition waiver and monthly stipend; Fulbright grants and federal loans for the US citizens as well as other types of federal support; government loans for Canadian citizens; a number of scholarships within bilateral cultural agreements between Bulgaria and various other countries; inexpensive dormitory will be provided to all international students in a residential area known as Student Town.

Application deadlines: September 30, February 15.

Starting dates: November 2, March 15.
